The administrative job of collecting Feedback from the Faculty Members in Academic Session 2023-24 has already been done and compiled. The Feedback contents and various inputs drawn on academic ambiance and infrastructure by the faculty members have further been studied and analyzed by a team comprising of Director, Registrar, and Coordinator, IQAC on **11th June 2024**. Following is a brief account of the observations made by the team members for the kind perusal and needful for the Members of Governing Body:

1. More emphasis should be given on revising ordinances and course curricula of post graduate courses as per contemporary need of industry and as per NEP standard as well.
2. All the teachers have strongly emphasized the need to include minor elective from other faculty, vocational courses and co - curricular courses in ordinance.

Action Taken:

1. A meeting of the Director, Registrar and HODs with Coordinators was convened where the Director instructed them to prepare totally revised new ordinance and course curricula of post graduate courses for the session 2023-2024 as per contemporary need of industry and as per NEP standard as well.
2. With a view to enrichment of curriculum, Director instructed to HODs and coordinators to include minor elective from other faculty, vocational courses and co - curricular courses in ordinance, and for the same, seek the suggestions of the BOS.
